









Search and Rescue



- CAP flies 90% of USAF-directed inland search and rescue missions.
- CAP ground teams and aircrews save an average of 100 lives each year.



Disaster Relief



- CAP assists local, state, regional and national authorities.
- DR Tasks include:
 - Damage assessment
 - Aerial reconnaissance
 - Emergency communications
 - Personnel & material transport

Humanitarian Assistance



- Includes missions such as:
 - Blood, tissue and organ transport
 - Medical supply and vaccine transport.
 - Aerial reconnaissance for people and vessels in distress



Homeland Security

- Reconnaissance
 - Waterways
 - Border
 - Key assets and infrastructure
- Communications
- Command and Control



Counter Drug



- To assist federal, state, and local drug interdiction efforts, CAP flies reconnaissance missions supporting
 - Cannabis abatement
 - Drug smuggling intervention
 - Illegal border penetration detection
- CAP's counter drug mission involves only DEA screened aircrews and command and control personnel.





Wisconsin Wing Civil Air Patrol



Air Force Support



- Assist the United States Air Force in any non-combative mission such as:
 - low-level route surveys
 - exercise support
 - air defense intercept training





Wisconsin Wing Civil Air Patrol



In FY10 Wisconsin Wing CAP

- Flew over 3100 training and actual mission hours
- 28 HLS/DR/SAR missions and 5 Counterdrug missions
- 12 Air Defense Intercept missions
- 8 aircraft ELT distress beacons
- 1 missing aircraft
- 3 missing person searches
- 2 natural disasters
